



St Marks Parish Church and the Good Shepherd Mission are our Church of England friends and are about a mile away from St Elizabeth's on Southport Road and Smithy Lane, Scarisbrick. They normally have a service at 11.00am each Sunday

They were also gifted the land by the Scarisbrick estate and was built by public subscription in 1851. St Marks can accommodate about 200 people and although traditional has a modern sound system, screen, and good quality organ.

St Marks has excellent ecumenical links with us and Bescar Lane Methodist Church.

And we love to attend services in each other's churches and share Christian activities such as Lenten courses and Remembrance Sunday. We also love to support each other in community events. This allows all our congregations to share a rich celebratory worship brought together by each denomination.

We think that our leaders share a common vision of serving our area; and in so doing can minister across the parish in a way that one church alone could not do.
