## THE CHRISM MASS, HOLY WEEK AND EASTER

The Chrism Mass celebrated last Wednesday, the evening before Maundy Thursday, took place in the Cathedral a usual. During this Mass, our priests gather to renew their commitment to their ministry before the Archbishop blesses the Oil of the Sick and the Oli of Catechumens, and consecrates the Oil of Chrism to be used throughout the Archdiocese in the year ahead. A huge amount of people from parishes across the Archdiocese came together in prayer, many by coach. Over Easter this year 175 adults were received into the Church (within the Archdiocese) through the Sacraments of Initiation. We congratulate them all and give thanks to God for the graces we received this Easter.
